

The Clinton Public Schools is continuing the process of identifying intellectually gifted students and students with exceptional talents in music and the visual arts as mandated by State Regulation Sec. 10-7 6a (14).

Nominations of students will be accepted from parents, classroom teachers and special area teachers. Students may also nominate themselves. Nomination forms are available on the district website, <u>here</u> and in each school office. Students who have been identified in previous years do not have to be re-nominated. Students who were previously nominated and did not meet the eligibility criteria may be re-nominated once annually. <u>Please keep in mind that student testing and identification generally begins in third grade</u>.
